

Festival Information for Artists



- There is no cost for artists to participate. Each registered professional artist will get one box of Prang Freart Large Drawing Chalk and one box of Sargent Art Sidewalk Chalk. Each registered Teen and Amateur artist will get one box of Sargent Art Sidewalk Chalk. Artists may bring supplemental supplies, however only chalk/pastels in a solid form may be used for the contest, and no acrylic paints, liquid pastels, etc. are acceptable. Please wear sunscreen, hats and knee pads.
- Each registered artist will be assigned an area of concrete to work with. Size of work area will be determined by location and artist's registered classification.
- Registration is required for artists wishing to compete. Registration for any location must be at the Farmington Public Library by Monday, May 24, 2010 at 7:00pm.
- The festival will be held on Thursday, June 10th from 9:00am until 5:00pm and Friday, June 11th, 2010, 9:00 am to 11:00am at locations in San Juan County. Artists will only be allowed to work on their piece during those times. All artwork for judging must be completed by Friday, June 11 by 11:00 am.
- You may participate as an individual artist or as a member of an artist team. Submit the proposed art with your registration for your square. Company logos are not to be used, and all artwork must be suitable for family viewing. No words or symbols intended as advertising may appear within the image. Obscene or offensive drawings, or language within the drawings will not be allowed.
- Prizes will be awarded in the Professional, Amateur and Teen classifications for Best of Show, as judged by a selected panel of judges, and People's Choice as voted by the public.
- Winners will be announced on Friday, June 11th at 4:00 pm.
