Entry Deadline is January 8, 2010

We are pleased to invite you to apply to the Riverfest Fine Arts and Crafts Fair taking place May 29 & 30. This fair is sponsored by the **River Reach Foundation** and the **Northwest New Mexico Art Council**.

The fair will be held **indoors** at the **Courtyard Marriot, Farmington, NM** during the 25th Annual Riverfest celebration in Berg Park. Participation is limited to 23 booths. The fair is scheduled to coincide with raft rides, free live music, Weiner dog races and other family events. Thousands of people attend this annual event.

All applications with payment must be mailed or hand delivered to be **received by 1/8/10**

Digital images may be submitted by e-mail or include on CD with application

This is an indoor fair.

All exhibitors are provided an 8'x8' space.

Exhibitors are responsible for providing their own set-up.

Cash award for best booth presentation.

Set up on Sat., May 29 at 7am

More details provided upon acceptance.

Booths are assigned as contracts are received.

Jury Fee (nonrefundable): \$25 per artist/ category

Booth fee

No more than 2 artists/booth total, both artists must be juried in.

- 8'x8' space, one exhibitor.....\$100
- 8'x8' space, two exhibitors.....\$60/ exhibitor

Susan Cardin: national juror, artist, and spokes-person for the Arts

Eligibility and Requirements

1. Only artists 18 years of age and older are eligible. An ID will be required upon check in. Eligibility limited to residents of New Mexico and the surrounding Four Corners states.
2. Artists may apply in multiple categories. Separate entry forms and digital images are required for each category. Each medium is evaluated separately; only one booth will be allocated per exhibitor regardless of the number of categories in which the artist is accepted. If two entrants collaborate in the same medium, they will be entitled to only one booth. Each collaborator must submit and sign the entry form. Artists juried in separately may share a booth, no more that 2 artists/booth.
3. Riverfest reserves the right to re-categorize work it feels has been entered in the wrong category.
4. All exhibitors must personally attend their booth and be present during the entire Fair. No representatives or agents may replace the exhibitor. All collaborators must be present.
5. Exhibitors may display work only in the category(ies) in which accepted. Riverfest reserves the right to remove an exhibitor who exhibits any work that does not reflect the quality and nature of work juried.
6. All work exhibited must be original work created by the entrant.
 - Signed, mechanical offset reproduction and/or giclee prints of the exhibitors original artwork will be allowed but must be displayed flat, labeled as reproduction and confined to a bin. The entrant must be juried into the show with their original artwork.
 - Matted prints and greeting cards/note cards featuring professionally printed copies of original images created by the artist are allowed in free standing racks or bins. They are not to be displayed on booth walls.
 - Photo/photocopies of artwork will not be allowed
 - Framed mechanical reproductions will not be allowed on booth walls but may be on floor and leaned against booth wall

- No posters will be allowed
- No commercial, manufactured or kit work including use of commercial molds, patterns, blanks, or dies will be allowed
- No commercially manufactured art tiles, mugs, T-shirts, caps, etc. are permitted.

Non compliance to any of the above will disqualify the exhibitor from participation

How to Enter

Submit three images of artwork for review via email to RiverfestArt@hotmail.com or by CD.

Identify each image with Title and a number, 1, 2, or 3 to correspond with entry form. The image file size must be no larger than 1.8 MBs at 72dpi

If mailing CD, send with application and check to **NWNMAC, Attn: Riverfest, P.O. Box 2235, Farmington, NM 87499**. Application, CD, and check may be *hand-delivered* to the Farmington Library, 2101 Farmington Ave, Farmington, Attn: *Flo Trujillo*

CD will not be returned unless adequate sized SASE provided

Notification of acceptance will be by email if email address provided.

Categories

Ceramics: Functional or decorative original clay and porcelain work other than jewelry. Machine made works from commercial molds and mass produced items are not permitted.

Digital Art: Work for which the original image, or the manipulation of other source material was executed by the artist using a computer. Signed and numbered editions on archival quality materials.

Drawings: Works in graphite, pastels, charcoal, colored pencil, chalk, wax crayon, pen and ink.

Fiber: Work crafted from fiber including clothing, basketry, weaving, quilting, leather work, papermaking. No machine screened patterns, mass production, or factory produced wearable items.

Glass: Stained, hand blown, etched, slumped, fused, etc. No forms or mass production permitted.

Jewelry: Jewelry produced from silver, gold, platinum, non-precious metals, beads, clay, glass, fiber, wood, etc. No commercial casts, molds, or production work allowed.

Metal: Non-jewelry works crafted from metal including copper, wrought iron, brass, etc.

Mixed Media: Any form of art which does not easily fit into other categories including gourd art.

Paintings: Works in oil, acrylic, alkyd, casein, tempera, watercolor and paintings under glass, mixed media

Photography: Photographic prints made from the artist's original negative and processed by the artist or under the artist direction and printed on archival quality materials

Printmaking: Hand printed, signed and numbered originals for which the artist hand manipulated the plates, stones or screens.

Sculpture: Three-dimensional original work done in any medium including bronze, wood, steel, ceramics, etc.

Wood: Non-sculptural works in wood that are hand-tooled, machine worked, turned or carved including furniture, bowls, etc.
